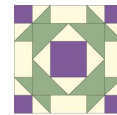

## Minutes of the February 2019 Meeting

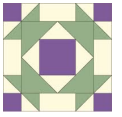
On February 5, 2019 President Janet Ferguson called the meeting to order and welcomed the members of the Shiner Heritage Quilters. There were 29 members present.
