Janet's Junk

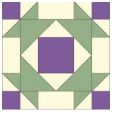

On June 4, 2019, President Janet Ferguson called the meeting to order and welcomed the members of the Shiner Heritage Quilters.

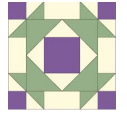
The Guild members recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dee Heberle seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

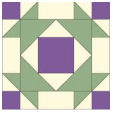
Irene Cerny gave a report on the Youth Quilting class being held next month.

The new block of the month was a success with 24 raffle blocks and 12 won by Marilyn Schroeder and Rose Mary Havlik.

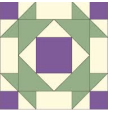
Show and Tell projects were displayed by Annette Meyer, Betty Kloesel, RaeNell Janik, Janet Ferguson, and Pat Myers.
