Minutes of the January 5, 2021, Shiner Heritage Quilter's Meeting

On January 5, 2021, President Janet Ferguson called the meeting to order and welcomed the members of the Shiner Heritage Quilters. There were 14 members and no visitors in attendance.

The Guild members recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Hostesses for the evening were Irene Cerny, Toni Rogers and Kathleen Schacherl. While there were no snacks for social time, there will be a drawing before the adjournment of the meeting for door prizes.

Janet asked if there were any corrections to the December 2020 Minutes and there were none. Rae Nell Janik motioned that the minutes be accepted and Carolyn Schroeder seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Rae Nell Janik read the December 2020 Treasurer's Report. There no changes made to the Treasurer's Report and it was filed for audit.

Toni Rogers presented Food for Thought, and November birthdays were celebrated. Members shared Sunshine and Shadows.
