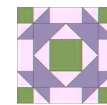

- Hostesses for the August meeting are Rhonda Orsak, Rae Nell Janik and Kathleen Schacherl.

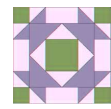
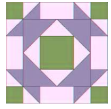
Block-of-the-Month

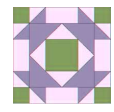
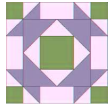
Kathy Riske reported that she has several kits put together for the nursing homes and Norma's House and they are available for anyone to pick up and complete.
