- Hostesses for the July meeting are Janet Ferguson, Mary Shafer and Irene Cerny

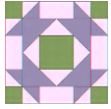
Block-of-the-Month

Minutes of the June 1, 2021, Shiner Heritage Quilter's Meeting

On June 1, 2021, President Janet Ferguson called the meeting to order and welcomed the members of the Shiner Heritage Quilters. There were 25 members and one visitor in attendance.

The Guild members recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Janet reminded everyone that because there were no meetings in February and March, and a quorum was not present at the April meeting, it would be necessary to present both the April and May Minutes for approval. Janet then presented the April Minutes and asked if there were any corrections and there were none. A motion to approve the April Minutes was made by Kathy Riske and seconded by Nola Bohuslav. The motion passed unanimously. She then presented the May Minutes and asked if there were any corrections and there were none. A motion to approve the May minutes was made by Wilma Williams and seconded by Carol Janak. The motion passed unanimously.

In Rae Nell Janik's absence, Janet read the May 31, 2021 Treasurer's Report. There no changes made to the Treasurer's Report and it was filed for audit.

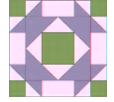
Old Business:

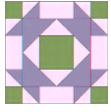
