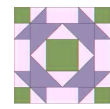

- If you have any ideas or suggestions for other programs, please let Kathleen know.

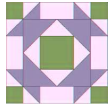
## Hostesses for Upcoming Meetings

## Janet's Junk

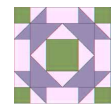

Rae Nell Janik read the May Treasurer's Report and it was filed for audit.

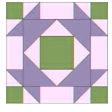
Toni Rogers then asked for Sunshine and Shadows, and June birthdays were celebrated.

### Old Business:

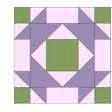
Janet turned the meeting over to Bernadette Kresta who reported that 30 quilts had been donated to nursing homes and Norma's House this year.

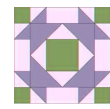
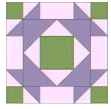
President: Janet Ferguson
