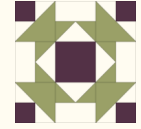

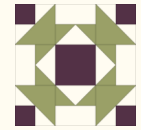

It is a challenge-block type quilt with members contributing blocks using one particular fabric along with whatever else they wanted to add. They had so many blocks they also made four pillows. The raffle will be the second weekend in November.

Debbie read thank you letters from the Shiner Lion's Club, Diane Greer, United Women of Faith, Norma's House and Leroy Hewig.

Debbie read a special "Messenger Transfer" announcement from Toni Rogers, selecting Rose Mary Havlik as the new Sunshine & Shadows, Food for Thought, and Birthdays committee. Toni presented Rose Mary with a special hat complete with a huge feather to commemorate the occasion.

Rose Mary led the group in celebrating birthdays and Sunshine and Shadows. She read a poem recognizing all the members for their hard work putting on the Quilt Show. The Quilt Show Countdown for 2028 is 679 days.

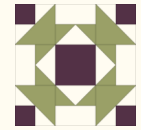

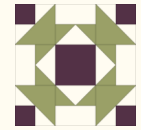
BUSINESS ITEMS:

LOUANN FISHER • ONE BLOCK WONDER WORKSHOP AND TRUNK SHOW

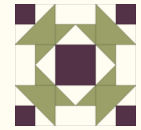

MJ has developed new classes around the research she has been doing in color theory.

This Color Theory workshop includes two segments. In *Lights, Camera, Action!* MJ explains how to apply the rules of color interaction to add sparkle and focal points to a quilt, while *Lit from Within* focuses on creating a dramatic glow with your fabric choices.



We will learn about these color rules and then sew a freezer-paper pieced gemstone block, using the color interaction principles.

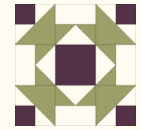

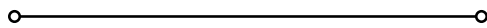
